

When will I get my jab



by mid-April 2021 and you will be contacted when it is your turn.

How to get your jab

If you are aged **16 to 65** and have an **underlying health condition** (such as severe asthma, diabetes or lung disease), or you are on the **Learning Disability Register** you will be contacted to have your jab by your GP led vaccination service.

For everyone else, there are two ways to get your vaccination **when you are invited**. You can book your jab online at www.nhs.uk/covid-vaccination or by calling **119** free of charge, or you will be contacted by your GP led vaccination service.

Priority groups 1 to 4

We have now offered the vaccination to everyone who:

- lives in care homes and care home staff
- is extremely clinically vulnerable
- is aged 70 or over
- is health and social care staff

More than 90% of people aged 70 and over in Sussex have received their first dose of the vaccination.

How to get your jab

If you're in any of the first four priority groups and haven't had your jab, please book online at www.nhs.uk/covid-vaccination, call **119** free of charge, or contact your GP led service.

Priority groups 5 to 9

We are now working through the remaining priority groups in turn, which cover people who are:

- aged 60 and over
- on the GP Learning Disability Register
- 16 to 65 with an underlying health condition
- eligible carers
- 55 years and over
- 50 years and over

If you are in one of these groups, we are aiming to vaccinate you

All other adults

The national and local target is to offer a vaccination to all adults by the end of July 2021.
